


SUBJECT: Policy for Mobile Team Medical Care for Cases In High Dependency Area OB/GYN Department

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1. Policy

1.1.1. Mobile ICU covers HDU gynecology and obstetric unit when patient is patient critically ill and is admitted under Mobile ICU

2. Criteria of Admitting Patient Under Mobile ICU:

2.1.1. Triggering the mobile team should be by the primary physician or the nurse in the case of an emergency, illustrated in calling criteria mentioned in the index.

2.1.2. For any medical reason, the nurse should communicate with the primary physician, except in emergency situations mobile ICU is contacted directly

2.1.3. In high dependency GYN/OB Unit, the patient can get all critical care management EXCEPT mechanical ventilation

3. Procedure

3.1.1. in the case of moving the patient out of their ward to somewhere such as the Radiology Department, theatre or anywhere else, it should be arranged with the primary physician NOT the Mobile Team

3.1.2. Daily follow-up of the patient by the Mobile Team unless they sign him off

3.1.3. The primary medical condition for which the patient is admitted should be totally followed by the primary consultant, unless he feels the need to discuss certain medical issues with the Mobile Team

3.1.4. Transferring the patient to the Intensive Care Unit is the responsibility of the Mobile Team

3.1.5. In case of transferring the patient to ICU, the bed should be reserved unless the patient is swapped

3.1.6. Central IV catheter is the responsibility of the Mobile Team but NOT peripheral cannulas

3.1.7. End of Life issues should be discussed between the primary consultant and the mobile team consultant according to the hospital policy.
